A Summary:

- Performance Summary
 - Appointment of Chris Jinno as APLU's Executive Director in early 2023, delivering high productivity and results throughout the year
 - Extension volunteer Ji Seung Kang's role as Executive Officer for an additional 2 years
 - Introduction of a new APLU Provisional Member of Uzbekistan, increasing membership to 9 Full and 11 Provisional Members
 - Preparation and planning of an APLU Sixes Tournament together with Lacrosse Australia for late 2023 (cancelled)
 - APLU and WL collaboration with members to achieve positive outcomes in development in the region, including celebration of Olympic Recognition for LA28
 - President Mike Slattery served as the elected Continental Federation Director on the WL Board, leading the evolution and performance of the now 4 CFs (AAL, APLU, ELF, PALA) and contributing to WL Panels and Working Groups
- Key priorities going forward
 - Support and guide ED to foster growth, coordination, and communication within APLU
 - Revise the Strategic Plan to align with WL's direction and incorporate Member needs aspirations
 - Determine and publish APLU's competition program for future years, complementing WL's competition planning and Event Sanctioning introduction from 2024 as well as supporting the growth and development of APLU lacrosse
 - Identify and pursue tangible revenue opportunities to fund development initiatives

- Collaborate with WL and local resources to initiate and encourage the Sixes experience for athletes, coaches and officials, in preparation for the WL WC 2026 and LA28 Olympic Competitions
- Liaise and support Members in achieving their National Olympic Committee recognitions for LA 28 progression
- Collaborate with WL and Lacrosse Australia to achieve lacrosse participation in the 2032 Brisbane Olympics
